Whereas James Alcock, has secured to us the publication abroad of our Dominion's Existence, Goals, and Aims by showing this Dominion's Flag in the Pickering Easter Parade in Her Majesty's Dominion of Canada, and by his efforts through the United Commonwealth Society made known our Dominion to others seeking stronger ties among Her Majesty's Realms,

Know Ye therefore that we by virtue of the several offices granted by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty to us, do by these Presents grant and assign unto the said **James Alcock** the Style and Title of **Member of the Order of Saint Barnabas**, and do further order that he be enrolled in that illustrious Order, as a Member, and be granted the **Medal of the Member of Saint Barnabas**, and all other rights and privileges associated with a Member of the Order of Saint Barnabas.

In Witness whereof We have to these Presents subscribed our name and affixed the Seal of the Dominion of British West Florida this twentieth day of April in the fifty-fifth year of the Reign of Our Sovereign Lady Elizabeth the Second by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and of the Dominion of British West Florida, and of her other Realms and Territories Queen, Head of the Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith; and in the year of Our Lord two thousand and seven.
