Know Ye therefore that we by virtue of the several offices granted by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty to us do by these Presents grant and assign unto the said **Paul James** the Style and Title of **Member of the Order of Saint Barnabas**, and do further order that he be enrolled in that illustrious Order, as a Member Knight, and be granted the **Medal of the Member of Saint Barnabas**, and all other rights and privileges associated with a Member of the Order of Saint Barnabas.

In Witness whereof We have to these Presents subscribed our names and affixed the Seal of the Dominion of British West Florida this fifteenth day of September in the fifty-fourth year of the Reign of Our Sovereign Lady Elizabeth the Second by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and of the Dominion of British West Florida, and of her other Realms and Territories Queen, Head of the Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith; and in the year of Our Lord two thousand and six.
