Know Ye therefore that we by virtue of the several offices granted by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty to us do by these Presents grant and assign unto the said **Ted Willandt , Marquess of Mobile** the Style and Title of **Commander of the Order of Saint Barnabas**, and do further order that he be enrolled in that illustrious Order, as a Knight, and be granted the **Medal of the Knight Commander of Saint Barnabas**, and all other rights and privileges associated with a Commander of the Order of Saint Barnabas.

In Witness whereof We have to these Presents subscribed our names and affixed the Seal of the Dominion of British West Florida this Twelfth day of July in the fifty-fourth year of the Reign of Our Sovereign Lady Elizabeth the Second by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and of the Dominion of British West Florida, and of her other Realms and Territories Queen Head of the Commonwealth Defender of the Faith and in the year of Our Lord two thousand and six.
