

To all and singular who shall have cause to see theses presents, I Robert VII, Duke of Florida, Lord of St. George, GSB, Her Majesty's Governor-General in and for the Dominion of British West Florida, in the name of Her Majesty the Queen-in-Right of the Dominion of British West Florida, Elizabeth the Second, send Chevalier Greetings:

Know ye all that I have, by the several Powers and Authorities granted unto me by Her Majesty's Most Excellent Grace, appointed Our Right Trusty Alan Goudman, as Our High Commissioner and Minister from the People and Her Majesty's Government in and for the Dominion of British West Florida to the People and Her Majesty's Government in and for the Province of Alberta.

Know ye now that Our High Commissioner is designated Our one and only Spokesman and Emissary to the People and Her Majesty's Government in and for Alberta.

Know ye also that Our High Commissioner has the Authority to express for Us our considered opinion in Council to Her Majesty's Lt. Governor and government, this Authority not extending to matters not discussed by Us in Council.

Know ye further that our High Commissioner and Emissary shall hold in the strictest confidence any communications from the People or Her Majesty's Government of Alberta, holding it free of subpoena saving only its intended recipient, and our own Privy Council in and for the Dominion of British West Florida.

In Witness whereof I have caused to be placed the Seal of the Office of Governor-General, and the Arms of the Dominion of British West Florida this 8th day of March in the year of our Lord 2007, and of Her Majesty's Reign the fifty-fifth.
