

To all and singular who shall have cause to see theses presents, I Robert VII, Duke of Florida, Lord of St. George, GSB, Her Majesty's Governor-General in and for the Dominion of British West Florida, in the name of Her Majesty the Queen-in-Right of the Dominion of British West Florida, Elizabeth the Second, send Greetings:

Know ye all that I have, by the several Powers and Authorities granted unto me by Her Majesty's Most Excellent Grace, appointed Our Right Trusty James Alcock, International President, United Commonwealth Society, to Our Privy Council in and for the Dominion of British West Florida.

Know ye now that Our Privy Councilor James Alcock shall have access to our Chambers, the Chambers of the House of Lords, and the person of our Governor-General in and for the Dominion of British West Florida, at such times as seem to him to be needful.

Know ye also that Our Privy Councilor has the Authority to express to Us his considered opinion in Council on any all Matters which he deems Fit and Proper, this Authority is not limited to matters scheduled to be discussed by Us in Council, nor shall he ever be called to account for the Recommendations offered to Us in any other place.

Know ye further that our Privy Councilor shall hold in the strictest confidence any communications from our Governor-General, the Members of Parliament and Our Privy Council, holding it free of subpoena saving only its intended recipient.

In Witness whereof I have caused to be placed the Seal of the Office of Governor-General, and the Arms of the Dominion of British West Florida this 8th day of March in the year of our Lord 2007, and of Her Majesty's Reign the fifty-fifth.
