

Whereas the Baron of Baldwin did in Haste and the Emotion of the Moment involve himself in an inappropriate exchange in a Foreign Land, and

Whereas Lords of the Dominion are to behave as Gentlemen at all times, especially when their actions may cause harm to the Dominion or its international reputation, and

Whereas the House of Lords assembled have determined that the Baron should be restricted from any further contact with the Grand Duchy of Westarctica, its Government, or its Citizens, and

Whereas the House of Lords has determined that the Baron acted without Malice of Forethought, and

Whereas the House of Lords is desirous to utilize the skills and knowledge of the Baron of Baldwin,

Be it Resolved by House of Lords of the Dominion of British West Florida:

We do hereby Censure the Lord Jon-Lawrence, Baron of Baldwin for Indiscretions Harmful to the Dominion.

It is further resolved by the House of Lords Assembled that Your Grace be prevailed upon to issue a Writ of Prohibition, baring the Baron from Contact with or any attempt to Interfere in the Government of the Grand Duchy of Westarctica.

It is further resolved that such Writ of Prohibition also bar the Baron from initiation of any contact with any Citizen of the Grand Duchy of Westarctica.

It is further resolved that the Lord Jon-Lawrence, Baron Baldwin, be retained in the House and that he be appointed Chair of the House of Lords Select Committee on Heraldry and Arms.

The Baron Baldwin being present at this Court in Session for himself to answer, and of his accusers to make challenge.

The Lord Marshall, the Solicitor General, the Earl Rum, the Countess Louisiana, the Baron Von Servers, the Baroness of Orleans being present and concurring. The Baron George being detained on other pressing business.

Agreed to in Court Assembled this 25th day of February in the year of Our Lord the 2006th and of Our Dominion the 243rd and Her Majesty's Reign the 54th.
